Issues to be addressed in the project plan and agreement:

Notwithstanding other information and clarifications that may be sought as part of the grant agreement and project plan development process, the Secretariat will ensure that project plan includes the following:

1. The establishment of low-volume paediatric ARV warehouse is completed during the relatively short project timeframe.
2. A transition plan initiated with the Global Fund, national programmes and other donors for effective transitioning to the Global Fund's Rapid Supply Mechanism by the end of the project.
