DolPHIN2: Dolutegravir in Pregnant HIV mothers and Neonates

Recalling Resolution n°3-2015-e, in which the UNITAID Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the UNITAID Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project “*DolPHIN2: Dolutegravir in Pregnant HIV mothers and Neonates*” submitted by The University of Liverpool; and

Noting the alignment of the Project with the Board-approved Area for Intervention: ‘Improving Adult Antiretroviral Therapy in Low and Middle-income Countries: Providing Support for Evidence-gathering on the Use of New Priority Antiretroviral Regimens for First and Second-line Therapy’;

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to USD 8,884,929 for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between UNITAID and The University of Liverpool.
