



Resolution n°15-2023-e

Cost Extension for the Project “Unitaid support to WHO prequalification of medicines and in vitro diagnostics, and to the WHO collaborative procedure for registration”

Recalling that Unitaid has provided support to the WHO Prequalification of Medicines Programme since 2006 and Diagnostics Programme since 2009;

Recalling Unitaid Resolution 20-2018-e of 23 November 2018, in which the Executive Board approved the commitment of up to US\$ 22,100,000 for the project entitled, “Unitaid support to WHO prequalification of medicines and in vitro diagnostics, and to the WHO collaborative procedure for registration” (the “Project”), implemented by WHO’s Department of Regulation and Prequalification (formerly the Department of Regulation of Medicines and other Health Technologies / Prequalification); and

Recalling Unitaid Resolution 31-2021-e of 10 December 2021, in which the Board approved the commitment of an additional US\$6,400,000 and extended the duration of funding until 30 June 2023;

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to further extend the duration of funding by 30 months to 31 December 2025 and to commit additional funding of up to US\$21,500,000 for the Project.

The additional funding and extension to the Project duration is conditional upon signature of formal amendment to the grant agreement for the Project.
