



Resolution n° 18-2018-e

Go-ahead for the development of grant agreement packages on preventing deaths from cervical cancer for proposed projects with Clinton Health Access Initiative (CHAI) and Expertise France

With reference to the Area for Intervention: **“Optimizing management of coinfections and comorbidities in people living with HIV”**, as approved by the Executive Board in Resolution EB27/2017/R5; and

Taking into account the project proposal assessments by the Joint Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Secretariat to go-ahead with the development into draft grant agreement packages for subsequent submission to and approval by the Board, of the following proposed projects:

1. CHAI (Clinton Health Access Initiative): Preventing deaths from cervical cancer by catalysing the use of optimal screening tests and treatment devices.
2. Expertise France: SUCCESS « Scale Up Cervical Cancer Elimination with Secondary prevention Strategy”

The Board recalls that, in accordance with Resolution EB22/2015/R3, the Secretariat may now use the Project Preparation Facility to support the effective development of the grant agreement packages for these proposals. This decision has no other funding implications.
