



Resolution n°18-2024-e

Extension of “Catalytic interventions to increase sustainable access to medical oxygen (‘MOXY’ Project)”

Recalling Resolution R5-2020-e, as amended by Resolutions R7-2020-e and R3-2021-e, in which the Board authorised the Executive Director to commit funding through the expansion and reprogramming of existing grants, to include activities aimed at supporting the global response to COVID-19;

Recalling Resolution R22-2021-e, in which the Board approved the commitment of funds of a total amount of up to US\$ 21,000,000 to the Clinton Health Access Initiative (CHAI) for the project “Catalytic interventions to increase sustainable access to medical oxygen (‘MOXY’ Project)” (**“the Project”**), with a project duration from 1 December 2021 to 31 December 2022;

Recalling Board Resolution R23-2022-3, in which the Board approved the extension of the Project on a no-cost basis by an additional 12 months until 31 December 2023;

Recognizing the impact achieved through the Project, together with the need to provide CHAI with the time necessary to complete originally planned activities, as well as support transition of implemented interventions, with a view to responding to increased demands for integrated and sustainable measures to promote oxygen access within routine primary health care in the context of Pandemic Prevention, Preparedness, and Response; and

Acknowledging the recommendations of the Secretariat in this respect, the Board authorizes the Executive Director to extend the duration of the Project on a no-cost basis by six months, until 30 June 2024.
