



Resolution n°1-2018-e

Go ahead for the development of grant agreement packages on new tools for vector control for proposed projects with Barcelona Institute for Global Health (ISGlobal), University of Notre Dame and Wageningen University

With reference to the Area for Intervention: **“Accelerating the adoption of innovative vector control tools”**, as approved by the Executive Board in Resolution EB23/2015/R3; and

Taking into account the project proposal assessments by the Joint Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Secretariat to go ahead with the development into draft grant agreement packages, for subsequent submission to and approval by the Board, of the following proposed projects:

1. ISGlobal: “Broad One Health Endectocide-based Malaria Intervention in Africa (BOHEMIA)”
2. University of Notre Dame: “Advancing Spatial Repellents for Vector-borne Disease Control”
3. Wageningen University “HerDInC: Herding Disease-Carrying Insects for Control: Solar-powered push-pull systems for malaria control”

The Board recalls that, in accordance with Resolution EB22/2015/R3, the Secretariat may now use the Project Preparation Facility to support the effective development of the grant agreement packages for these proposals. This decision has no other funding implications.
