



Resolution n° 4-2017-e

Medicines for Malaria Venture Supply Side Grant

Recalling UNITAID Board Resolution EB23/2015/R5 in which the Board approved the Area for Intervention: "Optimizing introduction of tools for the treatment of severe malaria" and Resolution EB23/2015/R2 in which the Board approved the Area for Intervention: "Expanding access to preventive chemotherapy in pregnant women";

Noting the need for supply side support across the portfolio of UNITAID-funded Projects within these Areas for Intervention; and

Taking into account the assessment by the Proposal Review Committee of the proposed Supply Side Project to be implemented by Medicines for Malaria Venture (MMV) ("the Project");

The Executive Board now authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to **USD 3,361,023** for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between UNITAID and MMV.
