

Resolution n°4-2023-e

Go-ahead for the development of grant agreement packages on *Preventing deaths among adults and children by simplifying Advanced HIV Disease management* for proposed projects with Clinton Health Access Initiative (CHAI) and The Aurum Institute

With reference to the Area for Intervention *Optimizing management of coinfections and comorbidities in people living with HIV,* as approved by the Executive Board in Resolution EB27/2017/R5; and

Taking into account the project proposal assessments by the Joint Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Secretariat to go-ahead with the development into draft grant agreement packages for subsequent submission to and approval by the Board, of the following proposed projects:

- 1. THRIVE: Transforming Advanced HIV Disease Care in LMICs through Comprehensive and Equitable Access (Clinton Health Access Initiative); and
- 2. IMPAACT4HIV: Improved Access to AHD Care and Treatment 4HIV (The Aurum Institute)

The Board recalls that, in accordance with Resolution EB22/2015/R3, the Secretariat may now use the Project Preparation Facility to support the effective development of the grant agreement packages for these proposals. This decision has no other funding implications.
