

## Resolution n°5-2023-e

## Cost Extension for the Project 'Preventing deaths from cervical cancer by catalysing the use of optimal screening tests and treatment devices'

Recalling Unitaid Executive Board Resolution n°7-2019-e of 18 May 2019, in which the Board approved the commitment of up to US\$ 32,958,435 for the project entitled "Preventing deaths from cervical cancer by catalysing the use of optimal screening tests and treatment devices" (the "Project") to be implemented by the Clinton Health Access Initiative ("CHAI") for a 2.5-year period;

Recalling Resolution n°32-2021-e of 10 December 2021 in which the Board approved the commitment of an additional amount of up to US\$ 8,059,700 and extended the period for funding for the Project by an additional 12 months;

Taking into account the assessment by the PRC and the Secretariat's recommendations, the Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to extend the duration of funding for the Project by a further 24 months to 31 March 2025 and to commit additional funding of up to US\$ 5,250,000 to the Project.

The additional funding and the extension to the Project duration shall not apply to the COVID-19 related Outputs and are conditional upon signature of formal amendment to the grant agreement for the Project.
