

Resolution n°5-2024-e

Go-ahead for the development of grant agreement packages on Catalyzing Adoption of an Expanded Vector Control Toolbox to Fight Malaria for proposed projects with Swiss Tropical and Public Health Institute, and Centre for Research in Infectious Diseases, Cameroon

With reference to the Area for Intervention: **Accelerate adoption of innovative vector control tools** as approved by the Executive Board in Resolution EB23/2015/4; and

Taking into account the project proposal assessments by the Joint Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Secretariat to go-ahead with the development into draft grant agreement packages for subsequent submission to and approval by the Board, of the following proposed projects:

- 1. CONVINCE: Country operationalized novel vector control interventions for malaria (Swiss TPH);
- 2. CANVeCT: Catalyzing the Adoption of a Novel Vector Control Toolbox (CRID);

The Board recalls that, in accordance with Resolution EB22/2015/R3, the Secretariat may now use the Project Preparation Facility to support the effective development of the grant agreement packages for these proposals. This decision has no other funding implications.
