



Resolution n° 6-2016-e

**ACCELERATING PATIENT ACCESS TO OPTIMAL
ANTIRETROVIRALS**

Recalling UNITAID Board Resolution 3-2015-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the UNITAID Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project '*Accelerating Patient Access to Emerging Antiretrovirals*' submitted by the Clinton Health Access Initiative (CHAI) ("the Project"); and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board approved Area for Intervention: 'Improving Adult Antiretroviral Therapy in Low and Middle-income Countries: Ensure market preparedness for the priority products';

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to **USD 34,116,827** for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between UNITAID and CHAI.
