

Resolution nº 8-2016-e

UNLOCKING THE HEPATITIS C DIAGNOSTICS AND TREATMENT MARKET

Recalling UNITAID Board Resolution n°3-2015-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the UNITAID Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project "Unlocking the Hepatitis C diagnostic and treatment market" ("the Project") submitted by the Foundation for Innovative New Diagnostics (FIND);

and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board-approved Area for Intervention: 'Development of better tools to diagnose HCV, in particular in case of HIV/HCV co-infection';

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to USD 38,264,301 for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between UNITAID and FIND.
