CHAI Paediatric treatment project: Extension Request

Further to the Resolution 6 EB16 and the Board's commitment to paediatric ARV treatment and diagnostics, the Board takes note of the transition status of the Clinton Health Access Initiative Paediatric treatment project for 2013.

Taking into account the recommendation of the PRC, and to ensure no stockouts of paediatric treatment while securing transition in 2013, the Board of UNITAID, subject to the availability of funds, authorizes the Executive Director to commit up to **USD 8,000,000** for the project extension *Paediatric ARVs*.

USD 21.7 Million of unspent fund will also be used to secure paediatric treatments in 2013 through this project. The funds will ensure procurement cover into 2014.
