



## Resolution n° 10-2018-e

### **Use of TRIPS flexibilities to increase affordability of treatment for HIV, tuberculosis and hepatitis C virus in middle-income countries**

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution UNITAID/2017/R22-e in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project “Use of TRIPS flexibilities to increase affordability of treatment for HIV, tuberculosis and hepatitis C virus in middle-income countries” submitted by the International Treatment Preparedness Coalition (ITPC) (“the Project”); and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board approved Area for Intervention: “Supporting the use of TRIPS flexibilities”;

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to USD 9,984,445 for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the grant agreement between Unitaid and ITPC.

Lead Organization: International Treatment Preparedness Coalition (ITPC)

Target Countries: Argentina, Armenia, Belarus, Brazil, El Salvador, Georgia, Guatemala, Honduras, India, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Morocco, Russia, Thailand, Ukraine, Vietnam

Project Duration: 36 months (3 years) from 1 August 2018.
