

Resolution n°11-2021-e

Go-ahead for the development of grant agreement packages on New tools for reducing maternal mortality for proposed projects with Jhpiego Corporation, London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine (LSHTM), and UNDP-UNFPA-UNICEF-WHO-World Bank Special Programme of Research, Development and Research Training in Human Reproduction (HRP)

With reference to the Area for Intervention: **New tools for reducing maternal mortality** as approved by the Executive Board in Resolution EB37/2020/R5; and

Taking into account the project proposal assessments by the Joint Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Secretariat to go-ahead with the development into draft grant agreement packages for subsequent submission to and approval by the Board, of the following proposed projects:

- 1. AMPLI-PPHI: Accelerating Measurable Progress and Leveraging Investments for PPH Impact (Jhpiego Corporation);
- 2. Increasing equitable access to tranexamic acid to reduce deaths from postpartum haemorrhage (LSHTM);
- 3. Heat-Stable Carbetocin for the Treatment of Postpartum Haemorrhage: A Phase III, Randomised, Double-blind, Active Controlled, Multi-country, Multicentre, Non-inferiority Trial (WHO/HRP).

The Board recalls that, in accordance with Resolution EB22/2015/R3, the Secretariat may now use the Project Preparation Facility to support the effective development of the grant agreement packages for these proposals. This decision has no other funding implications.
