



Resolution n°11-2025-e

Amendment to WHO Enabler Grant adding an Elimination of Vertical Transmission (EVT) Workstream under the HIV&COIMS Sub Grant

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolutions 7-2016-e, 9-2017-e, 17-2017-e, 19-2017-e and 13- 2019-e, 24- 2022-e, 13-2024-e, and 17-2024-e, through which the Executive Board approved the commitment of a total amount of funding up to US\$ 69,723,207 to WHO for the Enabler Grant (comprising the HIV and co-infections/co-morbidities ("HIV&COIMS", Malaria, Tuberculosis and Oxygen Sub-Grants);

Acknowledging the proposed inclusion of a new EVT workstream within the HIV&COIMS Sub-Grant, to provide support for WHO activities enabling the Board-approved project '*Country- and Community-Led Scale-Up of Accessible, Integrated, and Family-Centered EVT Services for a Healthy Start*' ("*SAFEStart+*"), to be implemented by PATH for a duration of four year ("the Proposal"); and

Taking note of the recommendations of the Secretariat and the Proposal Review Committee in this regard, the Executive Board authorizes the Executive Director to commit up to US\$ 3,000,000 to the WHO Enabler for a new EVT workstream, to be included for these purposes within the HIV&COIMS Sub-Grant.

The additional funding is conditional upon signature of an amendment to the Enabler Grant Memorandum of Understanding between Unitaid and WHO reflecting the inclusion of the new EVT workstream, together with the new budget ceiling.

Revised total budget ceiling: US\$ 40,058,231 (for the HIV&COIMS sub-grant) and US\$ 72,723,207 (for the Enabler).
