Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution n° 18-2016-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a full grant agreement package for the proposed Project IMPAACT4TB - Increasing Market and Public health outcomes through scaling up Affordable Access models of short Course preventive therapy for TB submitted by the Aurum Institute ("the Project");

The Board now authorizes the Executive Director to commit up to USD 58,887,058 for the Project, subject to availability of funds.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the grant agreement between Unitaid and the Aurum Institute.
