

Resolution n° 15-2017-e

Strengthening Paediatric TB Services for Enhanced Early Detection (TB SPEED)

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution 17-2016-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project 'Strengthening Paediatric TB Services for Enhanced Early Detection (TB SPEED)' submitted by the University of Bordeaux ("the Project"); and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board approved Area for Intervention: 'Scale up of better TB treatment for children';

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to USD 14,670,470 million for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between Unitaid and the University of Bordeaux.
