## Preventing deaths from cervical cancer by catalysing the use of optimal screening tests and treatment devices

With reference to the Area for Intervention: "Optimizing management of coinfections and comorbidities in people living with HIV", as approved by the Executive Board in Resolution EB27/2017/R5; and

Acknowledging the recommendations of the Secretariat and the Proposal Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Executive Director to commit up to USD 10,693,241 for the Project "Preventing deaths from cervical cancer by catalysing the use of optimal screening tests and treatment devices", subject to the availability of funds.

Funding is conditional upon signature of a legal agreement between Unitaid and CHAI.
