Preventing deaths from cervical cancer by catalysing the use of optimal screening tests and treatment devices

With reference to the Area for Intervention: “Optimizing management of coinfections and comorbidities in people living with HIV”, as approved by the Executive Board in Resolution EB27/2017/R5; and

Acknowledging the recommendations of the Secretariat and the Proposal Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Executive Director to commit up to USD 10,693,241 for the Project *“Preventing deaths from cervical cancer by catalysing the use of optimal screening tests and treatment devices”*, subject to the availability of funds.

Funding is conditional upon signature of a legal agreement between Unitaid and CHAI.
