

Resolution nº 18-2016-e

Go-ahead for the "IMPAACT4TB" proposal

Taking into account the assessment by the Joint Review Committee of the proposed project by the Aurum Institute, entitled "Increasing Market and Public health outcomes through scaling up Affordable Access models of short course preventive therapy for TB (IMPAACT4TB)", under the Area for Intervention "Enabling preventive TB treatment in high-risk groups", the Executive Board authorizes the Secretariat to go-ahead with the development of the proposal into a draft grant agreement package, for subsequent submission to the Board for approval.

The Board recalls that, in accordance with Resolution EB22/2015/R3, the Secretariat may now use the Project Preparation Facility to support the effective development of grant agreement package for this proposal.
