Catalysing the Adoption of a Novel Vector Control Toolbox (CANVeCT)

Recalling Unitaid Executive Board Resolution n°5-2024-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Unitaid Secretariat of a full grant agreement package for the proposed project 'Catalysing the Adoption of a Novel Vector Control Toolbox (CANVeCT)' (the "Project"); and

Acknowledging the recommendations of the Secretariat and the Proposal Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Executive Director to commit up to USD 18,135,853 for the Project, subject to availability of funds.

Funding is conditional upon signature of a legal agreement between Unitaid and Centre for Research in Infectious Diseases (CRID).
