

## Resolution n°26-2025-e

## Cost Extension for the Project "Improved Access to AHD Care and Treatment 4 HIV" (IMPAACT4HIV)

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution R4-2024-e of 8 January 2024, in which the Board authorized the Executive Director to commit up to US\$ 17,590,120 for the project entitled "IMproved Access to AHD Care and Treatment 4HIV / IMPAACT4HIV" (the "Project"), to be implemented by the Aurum Institute for a 3.5-year period;

Noting the opportunity to leverage the Project to integrate Mpox screening, diagnosis, infection prevention and control (IPC) measures, treatment linkage and surveillance into existing AHD platforms in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Sierra Leone, thereby building on Unitaid's current investments in the AHD portfolio by supporting and improving access to care for the most vulnerable populations in two of the countries most affected by the current Mpox outbreak;

Acknowledging the recommendations of the Secretariat and the Proposal Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Executive Director, subject to the availability of funds, to commit additional funding of up to US\$ 1,000,000 for the Project for Mpox related activities. This additional funding shall not be fungible with the funds available for the other outputs and activities within the Project.

The additional funding is conditional upon signature of a formal amendment to the grant agreement for the Project.
