



Resolution n°28-2025-e

Additional funding for Phase 2 of the Project “Late-Stage Development and Regulatory Approval of the Vayu bCPAP and Low-Flow Blender Circuit Devices”

Recalling that in accordance with and under the authority established through the Unitaid agility mechanism, as approved in Board Resolution EB33/2019/1, in August 2020 the Executive Director committed up to US \$1,413,487 to Vayu Global Health Innovations, PBC (previously Vayu Global Health Innovations, LLC) (“Vayu GHI”), to support Phase 1 of the ‘Late-Stage Development and Regulatory Approval of the Vayu bCPAP and Low-Flow Blender Circuit Devices’ (“Project”); and

Noting that the Board, through Board Resolution n°12-2023-e, authorized the Executive Director to commit additional funding of up to US \$3 million to Vayu GHI for the implementation of Phase 2 of the Project.

Taking into account the assessment by the PRC, together with the Secretariat’s recommendations, the Board authorizes the Executive Director, subject to the availability of funds, to commit further funding of up to US \$ 2 million for the implementation of Phase 2 of the Project and to extend the duration of Phase 2 by a further 12 months.

The additional funding and extension to the Project duration are conditional upon signature of a formal amendment to the legal agreement between Unitaid and Vayu GHI.
