



Resolution n°29-2025-e

Cost Extension for the Project: “Transforming Advanced HIV Disease care in LMICs through comprehensive and equitable access” (“THRIVE”)

Recalling Unitaid Board Resolution R3-2024-e, in which the Board authorized the Executive Director to commit up to US\$ 20,353,998 for the project entitled “*Transforming Advanced HIV Disease CaRe in LMICs through Comprehensive and Equitable Access*” (“THRIVE”) (the “Project”), to be implemented by the Clinton Health Access Initiative (“CHAI”) for a 3-year period;

Acknowledging the need for additional work within the Project to ensure uninterrupted access to the AHD packages of care for adults and children, and to consolidate progress made to date; and

Noting the recommendations of the Secretariat and the Proposal Review Committee, the Executive Board authorizes the Executive Director, subject to the availability of funds, to commit additional funding of up to US\$ 2,908,306 for the Project.

The additional funding is conditional upon signature of a formal amendment to the grant agreement for the Project.
