



Resolution n° 2-2016-e

Go-ahead for the development of project proposal for the “E-marketplace”

Taking into account the assessments by the Joint Review Committee of the proposed project by the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria, entitled “E-marketplace for the procurement of public health commodities”, the Executive Board authorizes the Secretariat to go-ahead with the development of the proposal into draft grant agreement package, for subsequent submission to and approval by the Board.

The Executive Board considers that a project of this nature would require a co-ownership and co-funding. The Executive Board therefore instructs the Secretariat to ensure that the grant agreement limits the amount of UNITAID funding, so that it does not exceed the amount of the Global Fund’s own investment.

Any potential UNITAID funding would therefore be committed only once the Global Fund Secretariat Operating Expenditure Budget has been approved; and as such, any potential UNITAID funding would be committed on an annual basis.

This decision has no other funding implications.
