

Resolution n° 5-2017-e

Malaria Vaccine Pilot Implementation Program

Recalling the Unitaid Board Resolution UNITAID/2016/R11-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for an amount of up to USD 13.2 million (USD 9.6 million for phase 1 and USD 3.6 million for phase 2) for the proposed Project entitled "RTS,S/ASO1 Pilot Implementation Programme" ("the Project"); and,

Acknowledging the co-financing by Gavi and the Global Fund for phase 1 of the Project as requested by the Board,

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to US\$ 9.6 million for phase 1 of the Project. Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between Unitaid and the World Health Organization.

Subsequent funding for phase 2 of the Project will be dependent on the Secretariat's analysis and evaluation of the Project for subsequent approval of the Unitaid Board.

Lead Organization: World Health Organization

Target countries: Ghana, Kenya and Malawi.
