



Resolution n° 9-2016-e

Enabling Scale-up of Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis and Linkage to Testing among sexually active older adolescents with substantial HIV risk

Recalling UNITAID Board Resolution 3-2015-e, in which the Board provided its go-ahead for the development by the UNITAID Secretariat of a full draft grant agreement package for the proposed Project '*Enabling Scale-up of Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis and Linkage to Testing among sexually active older adolescents with substantial HIV risk*' submitted by United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) ("the Project");

and

Noting the alignment of this Project with the Board approved Area for Intervention: 'Enabling scale-up of Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) with linkage to HIV testing';

The Board authorizes, subject to availability of funds, the Executive Director to commit up to **USD 38,166,170** for the Project.

Funding is conditional upon signature of the draft grant agreement between UNITAID and UNICEF.
