HIV Area for Intervention: "Expanding access to HIV self-testing in LMICs"

Having considered the analysis presented by the Secretariat during the 26th Session of the UNITAID Executive Board, the Executive Board supports the need for UNITAID to focus strategically on "Expanding access to HIV self-testing in LMICs", with a view to closing the current HIV testing gap and thereby contributing to reaching fast track targets by 2020.

The Executive Board requests the Secretariat to launch appropriate calls for proposal within this Area for Intervention and to present progress on implementation to the Policy and Strategy Committee.

The Executive Board also invites the Secretariat to present a proposal for the extension of the Population Services International (PSI) STAR Project -Phase 2 within the scope of this Area for Intervention.
