Taking into account the PRC recommendations (ref: document PP.2010.1.4), the Board takes note of the potential of this project, but has decided not to fund the project, Improved HIV/AIDS Monitoring: Pilot Expanded Access to Quality and Affordable Viral Load Testing in Three Low Income Countries Proposal, at this stage.
